

# Does your speech disorder impact your everyday life?

If you are over 18 or older and suffer from dysarthria after a stroke, you may be eligible to participate in our study.

## Use of a smartphone-based application for speech therapy for stroke survivors

Our internationally collaborative study develops and tests a smartphone application to be used for speech therapy for stroke survivors. The application allows patients to receive personalized treatment **remotely**, as an effort to improve accessibility and convenience of speech rehabilitation services. Study participants will be asked to:

- Actively participate in a **4-week** of our remote speech therapy program using the application which will be installed to your cellphone for free.
- Attend **3 separate lab visits** to complete cognition- and communication-related assessment and questionnaire.

### Participants will receive:

- \$200 honorarium (gift cards)
- Speech & cognition screening assessment

## Where does it happen?

- Treatment sessions will take place at your home.
- Assessments will take place at the Motor Speech Laboratory, Florida State University (201 W. Bloxham St., Warren Building, Tallahassee, FL).

## You are eligible to participate in our study, if:

- You are 18 years or older.
- You have no problems using a smartphone application (physically and cognitively).
- Your native language is English.
- You have no neurological conditions other than stroke.
- You have no severe mental disorders.
- You can read and write.
