KL2/CTSA MENTORED CAREER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

FUNDING OPPORTUNITY

The **KL2 Career Development program** funds highly meritorious faculty scholars for **two years**. Award benefits include monetary support from NIH or via internal funds:

- 75% of annual effort coverage that can be used for summer salary and course buyout.
- About \$22,500 annually to support training and the conduct of a research project.
- Preliminary evidence can be used for a larger NIH R-level scientific proposal.

The KL2 RFA is released in the fall, first to participants enrolled in All About Funding and via the listserv.
